

Learning Story Highlights

Mind blowing Magnificent Marble Run

Last week, a group of enthusiastic Junior children took on an exciting challenge: building a mega marble run using our brand-new track sets.

Working as a team, the children experimented with the mechanical wheel, exploring different ways to create the tallest and longest marble run they could. They shared ideas, tested out their designs, and collaborated to discover which combinations worked best.

Meanwhile, another group of Junior children set themselves the goal of building a thin but towering marble run, aiming to make it as tall as they were! Carefully sorting through the available pieces, they encouraged and supported one another to construct an impressive marble run tower.

Nature Accessories

Some of our wonderful Junior Children showcased their creativity and resourcefulness by using natural materials to design one-of-a-kind accessories. Exploring the front playground, they carefully selected flowers, fresh green leaves, and dried fallen foliage from the diverse natural environment around them. Demonstrating respect for nature, they focused on sustainability by choosing only items that had already fallen to the ground.

Using clear sticky tape to assemble their creations, the children engaged their hand-eye coordination, fine motor skills, and resilience, as attaching delicate leaves and flowers required patience and precision. Throughout the experience, the Junior Children took pride in both the process and the finished products of their beautiful nature-inspired accessories.
