



# DISCO FAQs



## Is this a Drop and Go Event?

No. All children are required to be accompanied by an Adult (Parent, Grandparent, Friend etc). Adults are required to stay for the entirety of the Disco their child is attending - please do not leave school grounds. Adults are also permitted to stay inside the Disco area this year given we have a much bigger venue.

## What will happen on the night?

Doors for the Junior Disco (Prep - Year 2) will open at 4:45 pm with the Disco kicking off at 5:00 pm and concluding at 5:45pm. Please find your child/ren at the end of the Disco and ensure that they are out of the Hall by 5:50pm.

Doors for the Senior Disco (Years 3 - 6) will open at 5:50 pm with the Disco kicking off at 6:00 pm and concluding at 7:00pm. Please find your child/ren at the end of the Disco and ensure they are out of the Hall by 7:05pm.

Please note that Juniors are not permitted to attend the Senior Disco and Seniors are not permitted to attend the Junior Disco.

## When do I need to purchase a ticket by?

Please ensure you buy a ticket through Munch Monitor prior to Wednesday, 22 October 2025. We have a limited number of tickets available at the door, however to avoid missing out on Disco time we recommend pre-purchasing as we cannot guarantee processing times.

## How will tickets to the Disco be distributed?

A coloured wristband (**Red** for Senior, **Yellow** for Junior) will be your child's ticket to the Disco and will be sent in an envelope to classrooms on Thursday or Friday afternoon in the week of the Disco. Please ensure that your child arrives to the Disco wearing their wristband.

## Will there be food and drink for sale?

Yes, our lovely tuckshop convenor will be running a canteen which will be stocked with Sushi, poppers, soft drinks, chips, lollies and Zooper Doopers. *As this is a children's event, there will NOT be a bar and alcohol should not be brought onto school premises.*

## What is not permitted to be taken into the Assembly Hall?

No food or drink is permitted inside the Assembly Hall - this is a school rule which is strictly enforced. We will not allow children to take glow sticks, loose items or costume props (such as wands or swords) into the disco, so please do not bring these along.
